

# Apprenticeship Program for Job Seekers (Magang) 1


- Survey on the acceptance status of Apprenticeship for Job Seekers (Magang)
   Program based on Regulation of The Minister of Manpower of the Republic of Indonesia, Number 6 of 2020.
- Among the responding companies, 25% accept Magang for job seekers, and approximately 30% including the company that plan to implement it.

- Doesn't implement Magang Program for Job Seekers (No plan to implement it in the future)







# Apprenticeship Program for Job Seekers (Magang) ②

#### **Numbers of Future Acceptance**









# Apprenticeship Program for Job Seekers (Magang) 3

 The number of Apprenticeship Program for Job Seekers participants accepted by the responding companies (259 companies) is approximately 4200 (as of 2023), and the estimated number of participants accepted by all Japanese companies is 7400-7500 participants.

### Number of Japanese companies (1569 companies) accepting *Magang* for job seekers.














# Apprenticeship Program for Job Seekers (Magang) (5)

#### (Q) Do you know about the Manual of Internship Program for Job Seekers?









## Internship Program for College and High School Students 1

#### **Internship Acceptance**







- Accepting interns from high school and college students.

#### **Future Plans for the Internships Acceptance**









### Internship Program for College and High School Students 3

#### Number of interns in Japanese Companies (1569 Companies)









### **Certification of Qualification 1**

#### **SKKNI Implementation**









### **Certification of Qualification 2**
